Prof. Susanta Kumar Das welcomed all the members of BOS and asked them for their suggestions about the syllabus of M.Sc and Ph.D Physics which was also communicated to the members and experts earlier through email.

Important resolutions of the meetings are given below:

- 1. Some courses like Statistical Mechanics, Solid state Physics, Electronics should be rearranged in different semester as per the requirement of the students.
- Course like Metamaterial should be removed from the syllabus.
- A new course "Experimental techniques in Physics" should be introduced.
- 4. Contents of the syllabus was revised as per the requirement of the PG students and keeping in view of various competitive examinations.
- 5. Some minor upgradation was suggested in few courses to enable the students for various competitive examinations.
- 6. For PhD course work the courses offered by the department should be renamed as Experimental Physics, Theoretical Physics and Computational Physics. The syllabus to be updated accordingly.

In the meeting it was decided that the syllabus will be revised as per the expert's comments and it will be sent to the experts. After their final approval it will be submitted in the university on 28 September 2021.
