Suggested that syllabus should be based on

- Common structure of the other department of the University.
- Before sending to the students in to the school(Internship) for need a meeting with DEO, Head of the selected school,
- B.Ed teaches the students as like as a regular teacher as per school time table

Prof. P.K. Acharya : suggested

- Their should be learning outcomes at the end of the every paper of each semester.
- 50 percent of the UG courses should be repeated at PG syllabus so the student recall and re capture the details content.
- Practical paper should be based on individual theory paper.

Prof. B.N.Panda

Suggested

- Practical should be based on field work.
- Intact Research and Statistics in a same semester so that students get comprehensive knowledge on conducting Research.
- Their should be overall of learning outcomes mention on the starting of the syllabus to provide brief introduction to the programme.
- Intact seven semester Int. B.A B.Ed and Bsc.B.Ed syllabus in to six semester and eight in to seven.
- Sending B.Ed students and advice to stay at the school and teaches(Internship) students as good as regular teacher of more than 2 to 3 month for practical field work .
- As per NCTE guideline 25 % courses is offered for self study to the student from existing syllabus.
- Prepare a standard syllabus for both M.A and B.Ed.
