They are requested frame the courses of studies for the session 2009-10 as per the following guidelines, in the next Board of Studies Meeting.

1. In subjects having practical there shall be 3 theory papers in each Semester (Sem.-I, II, III) with 50 (40+10) marks in each paper out which 10 marks will be for internal / home assignment / Seminar. Each theory paper will have five credit hours. There will be only one practical paper in each semester of 100 marks (Five credit hours) which shall be examined by internal and external examiners. There will be no internal component for practical papers. However, in Sem.-IV there will be three theory papers with 50 (40+10) marks and the practical paper (Special paper) will have 100 (80+20) marks and out of which 20 marks are for project / dissertation and will be examined by an external and an internal examiner in the practical examination.
2. Subjects without any practical component will have five theory papers in each semester (Sem.-I, II, III) carrying 50(40+10) marks. Out of which 10 marks shall be internal / home assignment/ seminar. However, in Sem.-IV there will be four theory papers of 50 marks each out of which 10 marks will be for internal / home assignment / Seminar. Paper-V (405) in this semester will be either dissertation or project of 40 marks and 10 marks for viva-voce (40+10) and will be examined by external and internal examiners.
3. For subjects having M.Phil courses, the title of the dissertation along with the name of the concerned supervisor duly approved by the department research committee shall be forwarded to the Controller of Examination at the beginning of Sem.-II.
