Further, the following resolutions were also taken in the meeting:

4. Atomization of Examination to be enhanced and brought under 'A' category as per NAAC requirements.
5. Prospects of revenue generation from SEED fund to be explored.
6. Collaboration with nearby industries and corporate to be increased to foster student internship program and student placement. Mr. Jalan will be the Ambassador of GMU and will coordinate the collaboration between corporate and industries.

7. Provision for financial assistance to teachers attending conference to be explored.
8. Support from industries to be sought to address issues like rain water harvesting, water conservation, energy conservation, water audit, water recycling etc.
9. More steps to be taken for water and energy conservation.
10. All policy documents to be published in the Gazette.
11. Industry and Commerce link to be strengthened in the Alumni Meet.
12. University to support for Patent Filing under GMU.
13. University to apply for various awards instituted by Government and other reputed bodies.

Sri. Ashok Kumar Jalan, representative of the industries in the committee came forward to donate 100 dustbins to the University.
