This memorandum of Undertaking made and entered into on this 01 December 2017 by and between the following parties:

- A. GANGADHAR MEHER UNIVERSITY, Sambalpur, which expression shall mean and include its successors in interest and assigns of the second part (hereinafter referred to as GMU), AND
- B. DEV SANSKRITI VISHWAVIDYALAYA, Haridwar, which expression shall mean and include its successors in interest and assigns of the first part (hereinafter referred to as DSVV)


Whereas GMU and DSVV are interested in entering into a MOU with a view of sharing a common desire to explore, extend and strengthen the functional relationship between the Universities and Organizations with well-established R & D Set up(s) in Yoga, Spiritual Enrichment, Environmental Protection, Education, Corporate Excellence and Women Empowerment in order to share the facilities and expertise available with each of them, herewith sign this MOU on following broad understanding:

1. The faculty/Scientists of GMU, Sambalpur and DSVV, Haridwar may work on join collaborative research projects in areas of mutual interest and may apply for joint funding to National and International funding agencies. Data generated through such collaborative research will be published in peer reviewed journals jointly by the scientists/faculties of both the institutions.
2. The scientists/faculties of DSVV and GMU take part in relevant teaching programs every academic year as worked out by both the Institutions. A minimum of 8-10 lectures in every academic year in Faculty/Scientists' areas of specializations, for the benefit of students, be delivered by the universities. Topics of lectures and days/time will be fixed by mutual consultation between the Scientist/faculties and Head of concerned Departments of the universities. The travel arrangements of visiting scientists/faculties from R & D Institution will be made as per rules. Honorarium for the lectures will be paid as per University norms.
3. Ph.D./PG students of Physical sciences/Biological sciences/Social sciences/Humanities working at GMU, Sambalpur will be allowed to carry out a part of their research work in various laboratories of DSVV with the permission of In-Charge, DSVV and the Institution will extend all necessary facilities and expertise to the research students depending on the resources available. While carrying out study at DSVV, the student of GMU, Sambalpur will be governed as per DSVV Rules and Regulations.
4. Exchange of academic and scientific materials and other information, under the umbrella of the appropriate agreement, such as Material Transfer Agreement, in conformity with the institutional policies in place.




5. The MoU will be effective for a period of 3 years from the date of signature.
6. This MoU reflects the respective Institution's commitments to terms and conditions mentioned in MoU. This MoU may be amended or terminated at any time by either party provided that notice of termination or amendment is given by the notifying party to the other party before thirty (30) days of the date on which the termination or the amendment is intended to become effective. The commitments, made before the date of termination of MoU, will continue to be operative.

This "MoU" is based upon the express Agreement that the information contained herein, or made available in connection with any further investigation is strictly confidential and for the exclusive use of GMU, Sambalpur and DSVV, Haridwar. This document shall not be photocopied, reproduced or distributed to others at any time without the prior written consent of the parties. Provided that, should any party be required to disclose any information subsequent to requirements of laws or regulations applicable to it, it shall be able to disclose such information as required without any prior consent.



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

FOR SCIENTIFIC AND EDUCATIONAL COOPERATION

BETWEEN

**ZOOLOGICAL SURVEY OF INDIA
AND**

GANGADHAR MEHER UNIVERSITY, SAMBALPUR

The Zoological Survey of India (ZSI) and the Gangadhar Meher University Sambalpur, agree that for encouragement and development of cooperation and exchange in areas of mutual academic interest, it is desirable to enhance research and educational processes at both the universities/institutes and to strengthen mutual understanding between their respective staff, scholars and students. The Zoological Survey of India, represented by Director, ZSI and Gangadhar Meher University Sambalpur, represented by the Vice Chancellor, Gangadhar Meher University Sambalpur hereby, enter into an agreement for academic and educational cooperation and have set forth the following Articles of Mutual Agreement:

Article 1

Gangadhar Meher University Sambalpur and the Zoological Survey of India agree on, but is not limited to, the following based on their academic and educational needs:

1. Exchange of scholars and scientific staff.
2. Exchange of students.
3. Exchange of academic information and materials subjected to provisions under the Biodiversity Act (2002) and or any other such legal bindings by the Govt. of India.
4. Zoological Survey of India, Kolkata or any of the 16 Regional Centres of ZSI shall be a recognized Research Centre (including conducting contact classes/ course work/

examination etc.) for undertaking Doctoral and Post-Doctoral Programme by the Gangadhar Meher University, Sambalpur.

5. The bonafide students and research scholars of both the Institutions will have access to research facilities and logistics at Gangadhar Meher University, Sambalpur and Zoological Survey of India, Kolkata or any of the 16 Regional Centres of ZSI during their course of work and research period for conducting field based or laboratory based research.
6. The scientists of Zoological Survey of India conducting research shall be recognised as Guide/Co-Guide for supervising Master's and Doctoral Programmes in Zoology, Life Sciences, Environmental Sciences and or any other Biological Sciences as the case deemed by the Gangadhar Meher University, Sambalpur and as per the provisions outlined in the UGC regulation 2010.
7. Joint Research activities and publications could be undertaken on the following areas:
 - i. Wetland and Riverine Ecological Study and Agro-Biodiversity Study
 - ii. Ecological Studies with special reference to Eastern Ghats Fauna.
 - ii. Studies on the different Protected Areas of Odisha as well as neighbouring states.
8. Organisation and participation in conferences and academic meetings, such as courses, seminars, symposia or lectures.
9. Other Academic exchanges that both institutions agree to.

Article 2

The implementation of each exchange programme or joint project based on this agreement shall be negotiated on a case-by-case basis and agreed upon in writing by both institutions. Any such exchange programme or joint project entered into, as outlined above, will form an appendix to this basic agreement.

Article 3

The exchange programmes and/or projects as mentioned in Article 2, are not intended to be legally binding documents. They are meant to describe the nature and suggest the guidelines of the programme or project. Nothing, therefore, shall diminish the full autonomy of either university/institution, nor will any constraint be imposed by either upon the other carrying out the agreement.

Article 4

In order to carry out and fulfil the goals of this agreement both universities/institutes shall designate a programme coordinator to develop and co-ordinate the specific programmes and projects agreed upon. The appendix, as part of the general agreement, shall include such items as:

1. Elaboration of the responsibilities of each university/institution for the agreed upon activity.
2. Schedule for the specific activity.
3. Budget and sources of financing for each activity.
4. Any other item deemed necessary for the efficient management of the activity.

The programme coordinators will be responsible for the evaluation of activities under this agreement according to the practices of the respective parties. Letters of agreement will be approved by both sides according to the normal procedures adopted by the signatory parties.

Article 5

This agreement shall take effect on the day of which it is signed and shall continue until terminated by agreement between the parties. Any changes must be agreed to in writing by both parties. A minimum period of six months' notice will be required from either party wishing to terminate the agreement.

As witness to their consent to this agreement, the appropriate authorities hereunto provide their signatures.

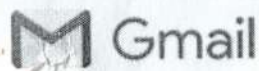
