

Observation of Subject expert Professor Deepak Behera.

Professor Behera wanted the researcher under the guidance of the Supervisor extensively undertake review of literature especially among both the tribes that is Juang and Pauri Bhuyan. He pointed out the very essence of understanding the concept of aging prevailing in their society and asked the scholar to explore on it.

He further emphasized that the researcher should capture data on different aspects like nomenclature used for the aging, the value system towards aged, to explore whether they consider that physical disability at an age or becoming grandparents or any other social factors which are considered to be aged.

Observation of Honourable Vice Chancellor GM University: He suggested that the title should be changed marginally so that it can capture the objectives in a more meaningful manner. He further pointed out how Professor Behera's valuable suggestions should be incorporated. The Eitle of the proposed coose is Bio-Cultural facets of Aged Amongst Selected Particularly Universable Tribal Group (IV TG) Of Odisha.
