5. NARAYANI PANDA IT SKILL CENTRE (Date of Establishment: 04.04.2023)



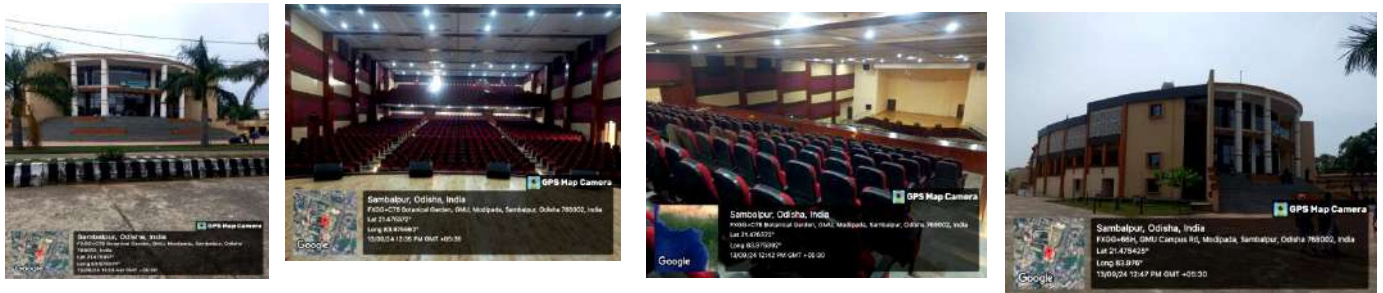

8. SMART CLASSES (Date of Establishment: 06.05.2024)



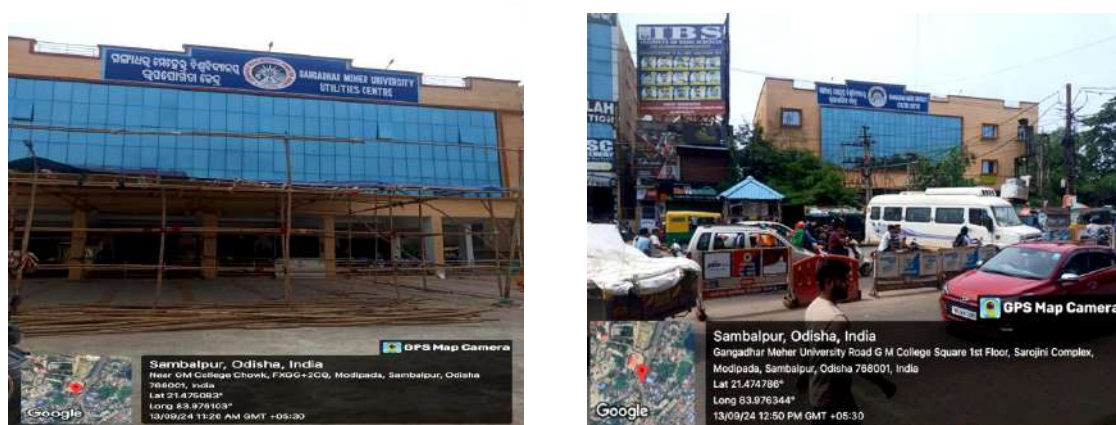

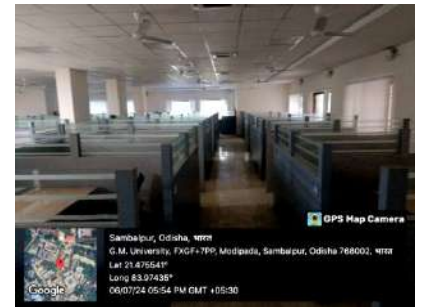
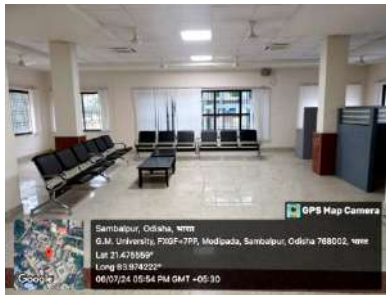
10. UTILITY BUILDING (Date of Establishment: 24.01.2024)

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made and entered into on 01 (Day) 10 (Month) 2021 (Year) between the INFLIBNET Centre, an IUC of University Grants Commission located at Gandhinagar, hereinafter referred to as 'INFLIBNET' and Geogitar Meher (University / Deemed University / Inter-University Centre), here in after referred to as the 'University'.

WHEREAS, INFLIBNET Centre, an inter-university Centre of the University Grants Commission, in its mandate, promotes open access to scholarly content generated in universities. The Centre has computers, network, software infrastructure and technical know-how required for hosting electronic versions of theses and dissertations in open access with interface to search, retrieve and access these content.

WHEREAS Geogitar Meher (University / Deemed University / Inter University Centre) has agreed to take part in the process of digitisation of old theses and dissertations (not available in computerized machine-readable format) and building-up of digital repository and to promote, share and host its ETD in 'Shodhganga'. A reservoir of Indian theses submitted to the Universities in India' and other universities in open access. 'Shodhganga' is a name coined by INFLIBNET Centre for referring to the repository of Indian Electronic Theses and Dissertations. The word 'Shodh' originates from Sanskrit and stands for research and discovery. The 'Ganga' is the holiest, longest and largest river in Indian subcontinent which has held heart of its people captive and drawn millions of people to its banks since the dawn of history. The Ganga is the symbol of India's age-long culture and civilization, ever changing, ever flowing, ever loved and revered by its people. 'Shodhganga', a repository of theses and dissertations submitted to Indian universities, is expected to keep growing to a formidable size as more and more researchers from India submit their research works to this ever growing reservoir. Under the initiative called 'ShodhGangotri', research scholars / research supervisors in universities are requested to deposit electronic version of approved synopsis submitted by research scholars to the universities for registering themselves for the Ph.D programme.

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) defines responsibilities, liabilities and commitments of the institutions involved to ensure proper system implementation, to meet the objectives pertaining to submission and access to Electronic Theses and Dissertations as envisaged by the UGC vide its Notification (Minimum Standards & Procedure for Award of M.Phil/Ph.D Degree), Regulation, 2009 dated 1st June, 2009.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual agreements herein contained, INFLIBNET and the University agree to the following terms and conditions:

I. INFLIBNET Centre

1. Provide access to ETD hosting server(s) at the INFLIBNET Centre 'Shodhganga/Shodhgangotri' to the University with accompanied software interface enabling University / its student to create metadata and upload their theses and dissertations in ETD repositories designed for this purpose. Academic Performance Audit Report: 2023-24

(conducted on 01-07-2024 & 02-07-2024)

Gangadhar Meher University, Amruta Vihar, Sambalpur, Odisha, India

1. About the Institution

Gangadhar Meher University (GMU), Sambalpur, came into existence on the 30th of May 2015 as a unitary institution of higher learning [The Government of Odisha Order No.11598/HE Dated 30.05.2015]. The newly formed University replaced the erstwhile Gangadhar Meher College (Autonomous). Consequently, the entire teaching and non-teaching staff of G.M. College were deployed to G.M. University and became the stakeholders of the newly formed GMU.

Initially known as Sambalpur College, it was later renamed in 1949 as Gangadhar Meher College after Gangadhar Meher, a renowned Odia poet. The College started on a modest scale with a student strength of only 192. In 1944, degree programs in Arts and Commerce were introduced, while B.Sc. programs were added in the year 1957. The College reached a milestone in 1964 when Post-graduate departments were opened and M.Phil. programs in various disciplines were offered by the institution from 1983 onwards. Pre-Doctoral coursework was also introduced in 2012 in four subjects to meet higher education and research demand. From the year 2018, GMU started offering Ph.D. programs in many subjects.

The institution was identified as the College with Potential for Excellence (CPE) by UGC in the session 2004-05. The institution added another feather in its cap when it was accredited by the NAAC with an 'A' grade in the session 2015-16.

2. Academic Audit: Modus of Operandi

The audit team visited each of the schools and reviewed the performance in the following four parameters.

(1) Student-related Performance (2) Research and Publications (3) Availability of Academic Facilities (4) Outreach and other General Activities

Each of the schools has made a presentation on the above parameters and interacted with the faculties.

3. General Observations

3.1 Students-related Performance

- The average graduation rate at the university is satisfactory which is the proportion of students who successfully finish their degree programs within the allotted period. This indicator shows how well students are engaged overall and how well the university provides academic assistance services.
- Notably number of students received honours or distinctions for their scholastic achievement. This involves receiving scholarships and honours, as well as good marks on national or worldwide standardised tests.
- The university boasts a placement cell with many graduates securing employment in reputed organizations or getting admission to postgraduate programs in several prestigious institutions of higher learning. This reflects the relevance of the curriculum and the role of the university in the career progression of the students.
- The University has a student feedback system. Further, feedback from parents and employers is also collected, analysed and proper actions are taken.
- Many of the students have participated in several competitions that are organised by different institutions across the country.

3.2 Research and Publications

- With the research papers, and book chapters published in high-impact journals, in the last year, the university boasts a strong research culture. The number of papers and book chapters published is satisfactory.

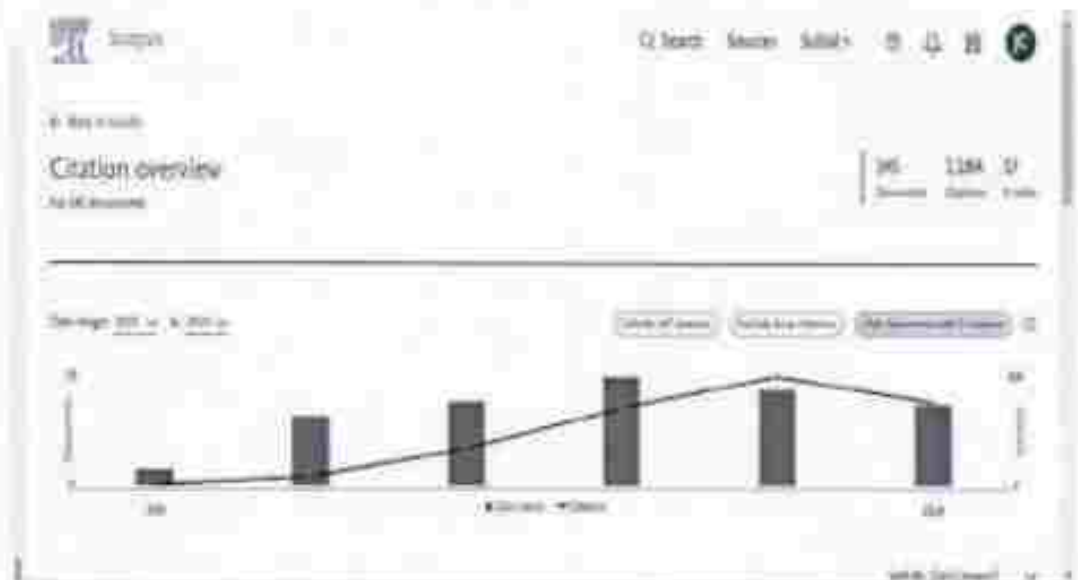


Figure 1: Citation and H-index

3.3 Availability of Academic Facilities

- **Library Resources:** The library has an extensive collection of books and reference materials and is equipped with more than 125766 number of books. The library provides access to stakeholders comprising students, faculty members and other employees both virtually and physically via digital platforms. Through the Odisha University Consortium, which is run by the Odisha State Higher Education Council (OSHEC), the library has subscriptions to EBSCO and ScienceDirect, giving access to a vast array of e-resources. Additionally, the consortium provides library patrons with an open remote access tool that allows them to access online resources at any time and from any location. Approximately 16448 e-books, 237368 e-journals, and 28477 non-journal contents, 1484 news articles and roughly 34897 e-books, 5090 e-journals, and 363 e-textbooks in EBSCO and Science Direct respectively. In addition to this library also makes available six million articles.
- **Laboratories:** The university is equipped with state-of-the-art laboratories for the concerned disciplines. These labs are subject to regular upkeep and maintenance to enable the learners stay updated and to ensure they meet the latest industry standards and support cutting-edge research.
- **Classrooms:** Classrooms are equipped with modern teaching aids, including smart boards, projectors, and high-speed internet, which enhance the learning experience. The university has also integrated online learning platforms to support blended learning.
- **Student Support Services:** The university offers comprehensive academic support services, including tutoring, counselling, and career guidance. These services are designed to assist students in achieving their academic and career goals.
- **Accommodation and Facilities:** The university provides well-maintained students' hostels with facilities such as study rooms, common areas, and recreational amenities. The campus is also equipped with sports facilities, gyms, a health center, and dining services that contribute to a holistic student experience.

3.4 Outreach and other General Activities

Key aspects of the audit include assessing the variety and scope of the extension programs, such as community service projects, skill development workshops, and awareness campaigns. The audit examines the participation levels of students, faculty, and staff, evaluating how these activities contribute to their personal and professional development.

The impact of these initiatives on the target communities is also scrutinized, measuring the effectiveness in addressing local needs, promoting sustainable development, and enhancing

the quality of life. The audit considers the resources allocated for these activities, including funding, personnel, and infrastructure, ensuring they are adequately supported. Additionally, the audit reviews the partnerships and collaborations with non-governmental organizations (NGOs), government bodies, and other stakeholders that amplify the reach and effectiveness of the extension activities. The outcomes of this audit provide insights into the institution's commitment to social responsibility and its role in contributing to societal welfare. The audit found the following key extension programmes of the University,

4. Recommendations

- The audit highlights the need for additional funding to support cutting-edge research. It is recommended that the university seeks to diversify its funding sources by applying for more national and international grants. Establishing partnerships with industry and government agencies can also provide alternative funding streams.
- The university should prioritize research in areas that have high societal impact and align with global challenges. Encouraging interdisciplinary research can lead to more innovative solutions and enhance the university's reputation in emerging fields.
- Providing comprehensive support services, such as grant writing assistance, intellectual property management, and research ethics training, can help faculty and students navigate the complexities of conducting high-quality research.
- Classrooms and lecture halls should be equipped with the latest educational technologies, including smart boards, high-speed internet, and interactive learning platforms.
- Though the science labs are catering the needs of the students, an updated laboratory with latest equipment are highly required. A Central Instrumentation Centre (CIC) should be created.
- The University has one centre of excellence "Odisha Centre for Geriatrics and Gerontology (OCGG)" and one chair "Bhima Bhoi Research Chair". The number of such centres and research chairs may be increased.

2021-22 to 2023-24
Gangadhar Meher University, Amruta Vihar, Sambalpur**

1. Introduction and Objectives

An administrative audit was conducted from 18.07.24 to 19.07.24 to evaluate the effectiveness of the administrative activities and compliances to various policies and legislations as mandated by the appropriate authority.

2. Audit Observations

2.1. Policy and Procedure Compliance

The University has developed many policies related to research and innovation, start-ups, IT policy etc. which are in line with the guidelines. Also, various committee and cells has been constituted as per UGC guidelines.

2.2. Academic Departments (All Schools of the University):

The following observations were made while visiting various academic departments:

- Inadequate Teaching and Non-Teaching staffs
- Science laboratories of the University need upgradation with procurement of high-end equipment for advance research
- Central instrumentation facilities need upgradation
- Educational activities should be started at earliest possible in the second campus
- More number of smart classrooms should be developed
- Steps should be taken for promotion of innovation and filing of patent

2.3. Administrative sections (Academic, Establishment, Accounts, Purchase and Stores sections):

- Financial audits are being not done regularly by local fund audit
- Account section is making delay in processing of bills/vouchers.
- Purchase section need to process urgent requisitions without making delay
- Log book of all the sections should be maintained regularly

2.4. Examination Section

- Time gap between examination and publication of results should be delayed
- Poor storage facility of old evaluated answer books
- Shortage of staff members in the sections
- Examination section is yet to be fully automated

2.5. Library:

- Inadequate books in the library as per NEP syllabus
- Inadequate e-resources

- Important databases have not been subscribed in the library
- Library is yet to be fully digitalized

Overall Recommendations:

- Steps to be taken for recruitment of teaching and non-teaching staffs
- Steps to be taken for fully digitalization of library
- Steps to be taken for automation of examination system
- Steps should be taken to make second campus functional at earliest
- E-resources in the library should be increased
- Steps to be taken for promotions of Sports activities
- More numbers of CCTVs to be implemented in the Campus for safety and security
- Steps should be taken for preparation of NAAC accreditation without making any further delay
