

- Those qualified for Assistant Professor will not be considered for award of JRF. Candidates who qualify the Test for eligibility for Assistant Professor will be governed by the rules and regulations for recruitment of Assistant Professor of the concerned universities/colleges/state governments, as the case may be.
- The candidate who qualify for the award of Junior Research Fellowship are eligible to pursue research in the subject of their post graduation or in a related subject area are also eligible for Assistant Professor. The universities, institutions, IITs and other national organizations may select the JRF awardees for full time research work in accordance with the procedure prescribed by them.
- Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes (ST) Persons with Disability (PwD)/Transgender (Other Backward Classes- Non creamy layer) OBC-NCL or per the central list of Other Backward Classes available on National Commission for Backward Classes (NCBC), Government of India website: www.ncbc.nic.in, candidate will be given such special concessions as may be decided by the UGC.
- Candidates qualifying for the award of Junior Research Fellowship will be eligible to receive fellowship of UGC under various schemes, subject to their existing possession of its concession/allowances. The validity period of the offer is three years w.e.f. the date of issue of JRF Award Letter. However, in case the candidates who have already joined M. Phil / Ph.D. the time of commencement of fellowship shall be from the date of declaration of NET result or date of their joining, whichever is later.
